

#### *Tongue Diagnosis in Gynaecology*

There is an array of disease patterns in gynaecology that often presents with early signs on the tongue without overt signs or symptoms for the patient. This includes patterns of blood stasis, phlegm stasis and damp-heat, patterns which often manifest as tongue signs much earlier than other signs and therefore easier to treat much earlier if read correctly.
